Straightforward and easy drinking with plenty of ripe fruits. (C) 13% vol

- 1 **Louis Perdrier Brut NV - France**
Light, bright and full of sherbet. Easygoing and refreshing it is not one to over-consider, but definitely one to drink with glee.

- 2 **Louis Perdrier Rosé NV - France**
A lovely pale pink, this juicy-fruity fizz is packed with bubbles and light berry fruit. (2) 11.5%vol Btl Btl £17.50 | 125ml £3.50
- 3 **Camel Valley Brut 2006/07 - Cornwall, UK**
